About the Cemetery

Bohemian National Cemetery was founded in 1877 by eight Bohemian fraternal societies "to provide suitable burial site for persons of Bohemian birth or extraction." Ten years later, the cemetery was opened to all nationalities on a non-sectarian basis.

After two expansions, the cemetery today covers about 124 acres, where over 115,000 are at rest in mausoleums, gravesites, tombs, and columbaria.

Bohemian National Cemetery has been listed on the National Register of Historic Places since 2006.
